Transition to Independence

MONTHLY ORIENTATION (2nd Thursday of every Month)

Education & Training

Training Tuition, Books, & Pre-Test financial assistance (client finds and enrolls in appropriate training program)

Access to Degree Program

Supportive Services Assistance while attending school (gas vouchers, course supplies, certification exam fees, etc.)

Financial Aid Counselor (Pikes Peak Community College) – attends orientation to discuss financial aid opportunities

Computer Classes, CNA Training, Real Estate Classes, Trade Schools, etc.

Steps:

1. Attend Orientation
2. Complete application
3. Meet with Case Manager (1hr. appt.- discuss individualized goals)
4. Active and ongoing case management (Self-sufficiency assessment tool)
5. Graduate (1 month, 3 months, 6 months and 1 year follow-up)
