# Medication Assistance Program

**Program Goals:** The goal of the Medication Assistance Program is to assist individuals in need that have difficulty affording their medications for chronic conditions.

The MAP Coordinator uses a case management approach to assist the participants. The coordinator works with the individual to complete forms for accessing various pharmaceutical company programs in order to help them acquire their medication.

**Funding:** The services are provided at no charge to the individual!

A grant from the Great River Health System Community Endowment Foundation and local donations support the Medication Assistance Program.

**Services:** The following are some of the services provided:

- Helping clients to obtain proper forms for submission to pharmaceutical company programs.
- Assisting clients in determining eligibility and completion of forms.
- Contacting doctor offices for signatures when required.
- Referrals to proper entities for other service needs.
- Assisting clients with paperwork in their homes if they are unable to get to the Des Moines County Center.
- Referring family health issues to appropriate health organizations.
- Follow up on applications sent in for approval.
