The Family Shelters of Delaware County are managed by the

Community Action Agency of Delaware County, Inc.

The Family Shelters are designed to provide a safe and healthy temporary home.

Assistance is given at the following locations in Chester City:

- The Family Management Center is a 10-unit shelter located on Norris Street.
- The Colony Building is a 13-unit shelter located on Welsh Street.
- The Wesley House is 70-bed facility serving families and individuals located on Madison Street (currently undergoing \$1.6 million renovation).

While at the Family Shelters, clients are provided the following services:

- Case Management
- Assistance locating employment
- Assistance locating permanent housing
- Childcare
- Therapeutic Recreational Therapist assessment and referral
- Drug & Alcohol counseling
- AA and NA meetings
- MH assessment and counseling
- Clothing assistance
- Food assistance
- Nutrition Counseling
- Furniture from CAADC Donations Warehouse
- Support groups
- GED instruction
- Transportation assistance
