- ◇ Basic Literacy Skills

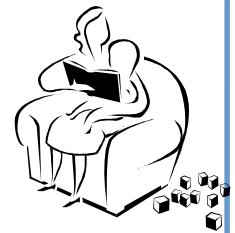

Parents attending the program participate in **4 educational areas** with their children.

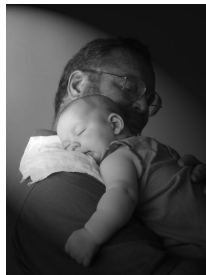
Adult Education Classes (1)

- Parents work on achieving the educational goal of their choice and participate in group projects (project-based learning).



Parenting Classes (2)

- Parents learn and discuss information and topics important in creating a healthy, safe environment for their family.



Early Childhood Classes (3)

- While parents are in their classes on-site, children are learning and playing in an educational environment to stimulate growth and development.



Interactive Literacy Activities (4)



- Children have the opportunity to play, read, and do activities with their parents in our early childhood classroom and in their home.



Other information:

- Classes are offered 4 days a week from 10am—2pm in the Mifflinburg and Selinsgrove area.
- Transportation is provided at no cost to those needing it.
- Family Fun Nights are held once a month.
- Free meals are included in class and during family nights.
